

2018 PONY CLUB Partner Horse Program

Purpose:

The pony club partner horse program is for the D3 level and up Pony Club members looking to gain more saddle time, build a relationship with a particular horse, and develop horsemanship skills beyond lessons and PC Meetings.

Requirements:

- Must be USPC member with a minimum D3 HM/Flat certification level
- Must attend mandatory monthly Carlisle Pony Club meetings (paid separately from this package)
- Volunteer at Carlisle a minimum of 2 hours per session
- Abide by all Carlisle barn rules, USPC expectations/safety guidelines
- Failure to meet these requirements may result in suspension from the program
- Sign off on PC Partner Horse Policies

Fees:

- \$750/8 week session (winter/session)
- \$1000/12 week session (spring/fall)

Details:

Participation in the program is by session, following Carlisle's seasonal calendar. Students may request a particular horse, but final assignments will be approved by Carlisle staff based on availability and suitability. Assignments may change session to session after evaluation and parent discussion. All lessons/practice rides are supervised by Carlisle Staff.

Session package includes:

- 1 scheduled group or 30 min private lesson per week
- 1 supervised practice ride per week
- Lessons and practice rides take place on Monday and Friday afternoons (3-5pm) during winter, spring, and fall sessions then shift to Monday and Wednesday afternoons for summer session.
- Use of partner horse for PC activities, including rallies, shows, clinics, Saturday PC lessons (paid separately from this package)
- 1 Make-up is possible within a session for missed rides on Saturday lesson days (included in package price)
