Adaptive Pony Club is open to riders of all ages and abilities who may require extra support and a modified curriculum of the Pony Club standards. This program maintains an emphasis on graduating through proficiency levels in horse management education, and riders have the option to participate in the Equestrian Center's community lesson program or the Therapy Center's Adaptive Equestrian Sports program depending upon the level of support needed. There are 8 monthly *unmounted* meetings running from March to October that dovetail with Little Boots and the Traditional Pony Club, promoting inclusion and assistance from upper-level pony clubbers, as well as self-paced options to achieve Pony Club certifications. Carlisle Academy is a recognized *Pony Club Riding Center*, allowing us to offer a center-level program and a modified curriculum without the requisite of national and regional dues.
