Stewarding animals, farm, and nature

The Working Farmscape Program is led by credentialed professionals focused on meaningful work and hands-on experiential learning in a restorative farm setting. Participants have the opportunity to care for horses and livestock, help harvest hay, rotationally graze sheep, tend to chickens, perform farm maintenance tasks, and extract fire and pulpwood from the farm's woodlot with the help of the draft horse team. They receive education in animal husbandry and livestock handling to better understand animal temperament, non-verbal communication, and trust.
