This program is limited to 8 participants who are active participants in Carlisle's ongoing lesson program (at least monthly).

Participants have first option for summer horse camps, horse shows, and activities with the older pony club program.

Fee: \$300 annual fee to cover the 6 sessions for the year. Three payments are acceptable. As this is a Center-Based Program, no USPC National or Regional dues are needed. This is a program that requires an upfront annual commitment.

Carlisle's Little Boots Program is a USPC Center-Based Program promoting the Pony Club curriculum and its values. It is designed for the young equestrian ages 5-11 as an introduction to horse care and horse management education which is foundational for the Pony Club standards. At this stage, ageappropriate games/skills, safety, and fun are at the center of all group activities including riding time.

During the 6 Saturday morning twohour sessions, students are assisted by the upper-level PC members and Carlisle certified instructors. The program includes a 30-minute group riding lesson and additional horse management learning stations.
