Program Details:

Pony Club will hold unmounted/mounted meetings for 6 Saturdays in 2024. Each meeting addresses the levels of Pony Club proficiency in riding and horse management, working towards the individual's certification track. All participants may go at their own pace and are not required to attend rallies. A group riding lesson is also included.

There are 8 spots available for members who need a Carlisle mount. These horses can help students achieve up to D3 certification in jumping sports and up to C2 certification in dressage sports. Additional spots are available for members with their own mount. Membership is limited to ongoing students enrolled in the lesson program.

Carlisle Academy PCRC is part of the Central New England Region. We come together with other Pony Clubs in our region to create scramble teams and attend clinics/other regional events.

PONY CLUB PROGRAM is open to youth of all ages and is designed for the committed equestrian interested in learning the Pony Club curriculum, the standards of proficiency of riding and horse management, and participation in center-based and regional activities.

As a Pony Club Riding Center, Carlisle Academy supplies program horses and welcomes participants with their own horse. Carlisle's nationally certified teaching staff with knowledge of pony club standards organizes the riding groups, meetings, and certifications and welcomes parent participation in activities.

Pony Club members are eligible for additional education opportunities including summer camps, clinics, onsite horse shows, field trips, and PC rallies.

The Pony Club mission to, *“develop character, leadership, confidence, and a sense of community in youth through a program that teaches the care of horses and ponies, riding and mounted sports.”*
